

Campaign Highlights

This last year, it felt like things were finally getting back to pre-pandemic normal - at least from a campaign standpoint. Fundraising is always a challenge and filled with wondering if we'll make goal, but our United Way is blessed to be part of an amazingly giving community that believes in taking care of each other and providing for those less fortunate. The support we've received is a testament to the wonderful people and place we all call home.



Our 2023 Campaign, "Because Of You," kicked off on Thursday, August 25, 2022 at the Betty Carol Graham Technology Center on the CACC Alex City Campus. Russell Brands/Fruit of the Loom was our 2023 Pacesetter and boy did they kick things off right! As a company, they embraced the idea of pacesetter and had a lot of fun hosting events, like Queen of Hearts, a dunking booth, golf tournament and many other fun competitions, in addition to their

annual workplace campaign. Their efforts paid off by raising \$31,428.43 as announced at Kickoff. But they didn't' stop there...in total, as a company, they raised/pledged \$35,689.87!!

This year we incorporated collecting new school supplies and non-perishable food donations for our area schools and food banks. Each area school system received 2 large boxes of school supplies and our local Salvation Army received 8 boxes of food for those in need.





This year, we also received an extra special blessing of a donation of \$100,000 from SL Alabama. This one-time gift was part of their efforts to increase their charitable giving and dedication to the local community. SL Alabama has been a faithful supporter of our United Way for many years, both monetarily and through volunteering, and we are grateful and humbled to receive this gift that will provide a long lasting

impact and change lives.

2022 allowed us to get back in to our area businesses, conduct workplace campaigns, and be out and about at community events to help spread the word about United Way and all the great things our 27 partner agencies and 5 community initiatives do in and for our communities.

In addition, we held our full scale Fashion Show again after a 2-year hiatus which was well attended and supported by the local community. The 4th Annual Wedding and Event Expo, Denim and Diamonds and "Football for a Cause" hosted by The Local at 41 Main, were just a few of the other events that added to our campaign total for the 2023 campaign. We have to thank each and every individual, business - small or large - and workplace that helped make this campaign year a resounding success. For the 2023 campaign, we are excited to have raised \$548,595.82! AND when you add on SL Alabama's generous gift, that brings our total to \$648,595.82!!!

THANK YOU to everyone who pledged, donated and continued to support our United Way during this past year. YOUR support means we were able to fund all 27 of our agencies for 2023, continue and possibly expand our initiative programs and outreach, but most importantly continue to help those in need across our communities.

2-1-1 continues to be a vital program of United Way and an important resource to our community at-large in 2022. Our call center partners across the state were as busy as ever taking calls to help with emergencies and every day needs.

In 2022, over 800 calls were made to 2-1-1 from our area. Callers were seeking assistance primarily with energy assistance, housing, food and health needs. This statewide service is fully funded through our United Way, and all the United Ways across Alabama, to provide emergency assistance and non-emergency referrals to agencies that can assist in times of need. The 2-1-1 system is a vital resource during natural disasters by helping to coordinate those in need to resources and organizations that can provide help in their time of need. As part of this initiative, our United Way annually participates in local mock disaster drills to stay prepared, as well as working throughout the year to keep our referral resources updated.

Additionally, the Lake Martin Dadeville Area Chamber of Commerce also held their annual **Denim & Diamonds** event in November 2022, which benefits our United Way and raised over \$6,400 for our campaign!

We were so excited to be able to bring back a fan favorite this year as well - our **Fashion Show & Silent Auction!** The event included a

runway, emcee, event lighting, food, VIP tables, entertainment and a Silent Auction! Held on October 20, the event was a huge success with over 200 attendees, 15 VIP tables, 6 local stores modeling and 72 auction items raising over \$11,000 for our campaign.
